



Wildlife Management Program

The deer management program at Treasure Lake is facilitated by the Treasure Lake Wildlife Committee. The Committee is responsible for the rules and policies that govern the program. This program is not a Treasure Lake amenity. It is a separate opportunity that is conducted on private property.

The management program is a primitive weapons only hunt. Archery, flintlock and percussion weapons are permitted. High powered rifles and handguns are prohibited on Treasure Lake property.

The Committee has established areas inside Treasure Lake that can be hunted. These areas are approved by the Treasure Lake Board of Directors. These are the only areas that can be hunted.

In cooperation with the Pa. Game Commission, the Committee obtains DMAP (Deer Management Assistance Program) tags for doe harvest. The DMAP tags are distributed by the Wildlife Committee each year to approved participants that have applied and are approved to participate.

The Committee has established a maximum number of available spots for the program. The Wildlife policies dictate who can participate.

If you wish to apply, the application must be submitted by JUNE 30th each year. The application must include a copy of a certificate or card showing completion of a Bow hunter education course. The application is downloadable and should be forwarded to this email address: gencon4@hotmail.com

For NON-PROPERTY OWNERS that are applying for the program AND returning non-property owners, the property owner guest form is required each year and is accessible using a link located below. It is downloadable and can be dropped off at the front gate before the June 30th deadline.
